

# Privacy Statement

## Public consultation on the review of the Code on objectivity, impartiality, accuracy and undue prominence



### **1. Objective**

The objective of this consultation is to receive the views of stakeholders or people concerned by the topic of the consultation and potentially to publish them on the GRA website.

### **2. Who has access to your information and to whom is it disclosed?**

The access to all personal data as well as all information collected in the context of this consultation is only accessed by the Broadcasting Division and the GRA Board members.

Received contributions, together with the identity of the contributor, will be published on the GRA website, unless the contributor objects to publication of the personal data on the grounds that such publication would harm his or her legitimate interests. In this case the contribution could be identified as being the official response from a political party or may be published in anonymous form if so requested. Otherwise, the contribution will not be published nor will, in principle, its content be taken into account. Any objections in this regard should be sent to the Broadcasting Division (see Contact information below).

### **3. How long do we keep your data?**

Your personal data will be part of a list of contact details shared internally amongst the staff of the Broadcasting Division for the purpose of contacting you in the future in the context of further public consultations specifically on this Code. If the personal data on the contact list is not updated or used within a period of 4 years, it will be deleted.
