Amateur Radio (Reciprocal) Licence

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must have a full licence in their country of residence; be residing in Gibraltar for the duration of the licence period and be 18 years or older.

APPLICATIONS

A completed Amateur Radio (Reciprocal) Licence application form must be submitted to the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority together with your full licence, passport or identity card. Proof of where you will be staying in Gibraltar is also required.

The Reciprocal Licence will permit the holder to transmit on the following Amateur Bands:

- (a) 70cm (430 - 440 MHz)
- (b) 2 Meters (144 MHz)
- (c) 4 Meters (70 – 70.5 MHz)
- (d) 6 Meters (50 MHz)

Output is restricted to a maximum of 100 watts erp.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must have an up to date Class A licence in their country of residence.

CONDITIONS OF USE

The Licensee shall operate the Station only under the terms and limitations of this Licence and the Station shall be operated only by the Licensee personally.

The Licensee shall ensure that the apparatus comprised in the Station is designed and constructed, and maintained and used, so that its use does not cause any undue interference to any radiocommunications equipment.

Use of Linear amplifiers is not allowed in Gibraltar and the maximum output will at no time exceed 100 watts erp.

The Licensee shall not transmit such material as music or public broadcasts.

LICENCE FEES

There is no licence fee applicable and the duration of licence will be for the period specified in the licence.
